

**Rev. Sean Daenzer**Director of Worship/International Center Chaplain

The Rev. Sean Daenzer serves two roles at the LCMS International Center (IC), one as the Synod's director of worship and the other as the IC chaplain.

As director of worship, Daenzer is responsible for proposing and creating programs that carry out the purposes and aims of the Synod in matters of worship. As IC chaplain, he works with the Office of the President in planning and supervising all chapel services at the IC as well as offering chaplaincy and

informal counseling services to employees as requested.

To this position, Daenzer brings prior experience as an organist and choir director (three years) and as a parish pastor (seven years). Most recently, he served as pastor of Peace Lutheran Church in Barney, N.D., and Trinity Lutheran Church in Great Bend, N.D., where he was privileged to lead an accomplished four-voice youth choir. He also was circuit visitor to the North Dakota District's Southeast Circuit.

In addition, he is a contributor for Concordia Publishing House's recently released *Lutheran Service Book: Companion to the Hymns*, a regular radio guest on Worldwide KFUO's "Sharper Iron" program and "The Gottesdienst Crowd" podcast, and the writer of several articles that have appeared in *The Lutheran Witness*.

Daenzer's service to the church also includes writing lectionary summaries and recording chant aids for LCMS Worship; teaching at Higher Things conferences and retreats; and serving as a delegate to three Synod conventions, including as a floor committee member for two of them.

Daenzer holds a Bachelor of Music in Organ from Hope College, Holland, Mich. (2006), and a Master of Divinity from Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne, Ind. (2011).

Daenzer and his wife, Audrey, have three living children (Lucia, Monica and Renata) and two awaiting the resurrection (Perpetua and Matthias).
